Constitution and Bylaws

SOCIETY ACT
CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is The Rover-Landers of British Columbia.
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - (a) To establish, maintain and operate a Land Rover owners and enthusiasts club.
 - (b) To organize, without profit, to its members mainly off-pavement driving events, social events and information sessions.
 - (c) To share with its members technical information and ideas regarding maintenance, restoration, use and preservation of all Land Rover products.
 - (d) To raise funds to enable the Society to carry out its purposes.
 - (e) To accept and receive such gifts, grants, donations, legacies, bequests, memorial funds, endowments and similar gratuitous dispositions of money and of personal and real property from all sources including corporations and other charitable organizations and other funds as may be, deemed appropriate for use in carrying out the purposes of the Society.
 - (f) To hold and keep invested the money proceeds of the aforesaid gifts and other dispositions from time to time.
 - (g) To engage in activities which will be of benefit to the Society and those using its services.
3. The activities and purposes of the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any income, profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used in promoting the purposes of the Society and all of the purposes of the Society shall be carried on an exclusively charitable basis.
4. In the event of the winding-up or dissolution of the Society, all funds and assets of the Society remaining after the payment or satisfaction of all costs, charges, expenses, debts and liabilities of the Society, including the remuneration (if any) of the liquidator, and after payment to employees of the Society of any arrears of salaries or wages, after the payment of any debts of the Society, shall first be given, transferred and distributed to such organizations that are registered charities pursuant to the provisions of the *Income Tax Act* that shall be designated by the members of the Society at the time of the winding-up or the dissolution of the Society which may have purposes similar to those of the Society.
5. No member, director or officer shall receive any gain, profit or dividend as a result of membership in the Society or be remunerated for being or acting as a director or officer, but a member, director or officer may be reimbursed for all expenses necessarily and reasonably incurred while engaged in the affairs of the Society.
6. Paragraphs 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Constitution are unalterable in accordance with the *Society Act*.

BYLAWS

The bylaws of the Society are those set out in Schedule B to the *Society Act* with the following variations, deletions and additions:

5(a) Membership of the Society may consist of owners or operators of Land Rover Vehicles and persons interested in the preservation of Land Rover Vehicles and every member must uphold the constitution and comply with these bylaws.

5(b) Membership shall consist of three categories:

(i) persons residing within the Province of British Columbia shall be identified as full members ("Full Members") and be accorded voting privileges and the privilege to hold office as a director of the Society;

(ii) persons residing outside the Province of British Columbia shall be identified as associate members ("Associate Members") and shall not be accorded voting privileges or the privilege to hold office as a director of the Society;

(iii) persons recognized by the directors for their outstanding contribution to the Society's growth and development, shall be identified as honorary members ("Honorary Members"). Honorary Members are not accorded voting privileges or the privilege to hold office as a director unless they join the Society as Full Members.

8(4) During an event, failure by a member to operate the member's vehicle in a responsible manner shall, subject to an opportunity to be heard as set out in Article 8(3), be grounds for expulsion.

9(1) Subject to 9(2) all members are in good standing except a member who has failed to pay his or her current annual membership fee, or any other subscription or debt due and owing by the member to the Society, and the member is not in good standing so long as the debt remains unpaid.

9(2) Honorary Members are not required to pay membership fees or dues.

9(3) So long as a member remains not in good standing, such member shall not participate in any event.
